US-11S/US-15/CAMP HILL (1.1 mi), BYP/CUMBERLAND BLVD. Continue to follow US-11/US-15
Turn RIGHT onto MARKET ST (1.0 mi), MARKET ST become CARLISLE PIKE (3.6 Mi), Turn RIGHT
onto SAMPLE BRIDGE ROAD. 5 SAMPLE BRIDGE ROAD is on the left.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW & HOTEL

DIRECTIONS

From Harrisburg International Airport and Lancaster - Travel I-283 West (toward Harrisburg) to I-83 South to Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West). Then take Exit 5A (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the left.

From Philadelphia Area - Travel I-76 West (PA Turnpike) to Exit 236 (Gettysburg). Go North on Route 15 for approximately 6 miles, the Radisson is on the left.

From Pittsburgh Area - Travel I-76 East (PA Turnpike) to Exit 236 (Gettysburg). Go North on Route 15 for approximately 6 miles, the Radisson is on the left.

From New York City - From the George Washington Bridge, the Holland or Lincoln Tunnels, follow the New Jersey Turnpike South to Exit 14 (I-78 West). Then take I-81 South and get off at Exit 65 (Enola/Marysville). Travel Routes 11/15 South for approximately 5 miles. At the 5th traffic light, turn right onto Walnut Street. Continue straight through two more traffic lights and the Radisson is on the right.

From Upstate New York, Northeastern Pennsylvania and Canada - From the Pennsylvania border, travel I-81 South and take at Exit 65 (Enola/Marysville). Travel Routes 11/15 South for approximately 5 miles. At the 5th traffic light, turn right onto Walnut Street. Continue straight through two more traffic lights and the Radisson is on the right.

From Allentown and Bethlehem - From the Pennsylvania border, travel I-83 North to Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West) then take Exit 5 (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the right.

From York, Baltimore and Washington D.C. - From the Pennsylvania border, travel I-83 North to Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West) then take Exit 5A (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the right.

From State College - Travel Route 322 to Route 11/15 South. At the 5th traffic light, turn right onto Walnut Street. Go straight for two more traffic lights and the Radisson is on the right.

From Hershey - Travel Route 322 West to I-83 South. Take Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West). Then take Exit 5A (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the left.

Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or in harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip or left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety as this is considered mistreatment.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS HOTEL & DOG SHOW RULES

- A "Rules for Guest Conduct Contract" will be given out at the Registration Desk of the Host Hotel. Anyone refusing to sign the contract will not be given a room under the umbrella of The Chow Chow Club, Inc.
 - All guest should make a thorough check of their rooms upon arrival and report any damage - Plastic is required under all dog crates.
 - A maximum of four (4) persons are permitted in each resort room.
 - All dogs must be in crates when there is not a responsible person present in the room.
 - Damages to the rooms are the responsibility of the occupant and must be settled with the hotel prior to departure, or future specialties will be denied.
 - Keep your rooms clean and orderly. Housekeeping is required to check your room to be cleaned daily NO EXCEPTIONS.
 - Dogs must be on leash at all times or confined in their crates, except when being judged and groomed.
 - Dogs must be on leash when walking in resort rooms, hallways or any public areas of the hotel. No dogs are allowed in or near any food service outlet. Dogs are not permitted poolside or in any public restrooms.
 - Exercise dogs ONLY in the designated areas. Please clean up after exercising your dogs; equipment will be available for your convenience. Waste must be deposited in poop buckets provided by the club. If the area you are in does not have a bucket, it is NOT an exercise area.
 - The Grooming Area is a privilege extended by the Chow Chow Club, Inc. and the Radisson Penn Harris Hotel and Convention Center, which, can and will be withdrawn from those who do not follow the instructions and rules of the Show Committee.
 - Grooming allowed in designated areas only. A spacious grooming area will be provided. NO BATHING AND GROOMING OF DOGS ALLOWED IN HOTEL ROOMS, hallways or ballrooms. If there is any grooming found by the Hotel Staff or Show Committee in these areas, you will be asked to leave. Exhibitors are responsible for damages and clean up of their grooming area daily. Clean up supplies will be available.
 - The Dog Wash (includes wet blow dry) will be held outdoors in the designated wash area.
 - The Show Committee will lay out and govern the designated Grooming Area. Grooming space will be available on a first come, first served basis. No space may be roped off or held with empty crates. To assure room for all exhibitors, please conserve and share space. The Show Committee reserved the right to condense an exhibitors grooming area. NO DOGS TO BE LEFT IN THE GROOMING ROOMS OVERNIGHT.
 - The Show Committee will govern the use of Private Exercise Pens. NO indoor exercise pens.
 - There will be NO security guard on duty. DO NOT leave valuables out in the grooming areas. The Chow Chow Club, Inc., the Wine Country Chow Chow Association of New York, and the Radisson Penn Harris Hotel and Convention Center will not be responsible for anything stolen or damaged.
 - Disruptive guests (and/or their dogs) may be asked to leave. Dogs are not to create a nuisance by continually howling or barking.
 - Any damage to the hotel facilities (including grounds, parking lots) is up for disciplinary action by The Chow Chow Club, Inc. Bench Show Committee and the American Kennel Club.
- CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.**
DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.
JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show Superintendent to be advised at once. The Show Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD OR AN ATTENDEE'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor or attendee. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors and attendees will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the show.
ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG SHOWS hereby waive any claim for damages against the The Chow Chow Club, Inc. its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
